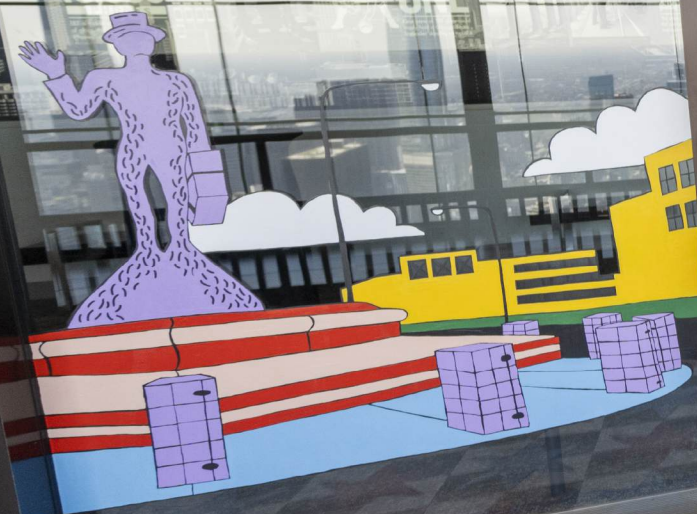
She is drawn to ordinary objects and places that are easily recognizable by people. Chung creates art with the intention to bring joy, spark memories, and radiate creativity.
